Cross Over Community Development is looking for support and volunteers to deepen their work. COCD, a 501C3 organization, is a resource center for immigrants and underserved communities that provides educational services and employment opportunities in the greater Dayton area. COCD programs are free and open to all but are designed specifically to meet the needs of learners from oral cultures who pass down history and inform through generations by word of mouth instead of recording historical data via print as is done in the western world.

Please consider the needs listed below and share them with your friends, service organizations and faith communities. Most can be done from your home.

Volunteers Needed:

- **Writer** who can create new content for the COCD website based on information that Catherine will provide.
- **Social Media** volunteer to post updates.
- **Coach/consultant who has experience in residential and institutional cleaning** to train new workers in the Cleaning Cooperative that is being created through Co-op Dayton's incubator program. (This may be a paid consultant position while a co-op worker prepares to take on the job.)
- **Cooperative organizer** to be part of a volunteer team (meeting weekly or biweekly) to plan for the Cleaning Cooperative start-up.
- **Grant writers.**
- **Math, English and Social Studies Tutors** (currently online)
- **Mentors** to accompany refugees as they transition to life in the U.S.
